Frequently asked questions

When is the Conference taking place?

The Conference is on the 19th and 20th of October from 9am until 5pm.

Can I attend both days?

Both days are applicable to SLTs working with adults post brain or spinal cord injury. Only the 19th of October is suitable for SLTs working with paediatric patients post brain or spinal cord injury.

As an SLT working with adults, do I have to attend both days?

No. You have the option to attend either day or both days.

What is the registration fee?

A 1-day ticket is €50 or a 2-day ticket is €75.

Are tickets refundable?

No. Tickets are non-refundable.

Is the Conference taking place in the National Rehabilitation Hospital?

No. The Conference is being held in the DLR LexIcon.

How do I find the DLR LexIcon?

The DLR LexIcon is located in Dún Laoghaire. Public transport routes that serve <u>Dún</u> Laoghaire include: Dublin bus routes 7, 46a, 59 and 75 & DART: Dun Laoghaire.

Can I attend virtually?

No, unfortunately virtual attendance is not available. The afternoon workshops involve hands-on activities to allow attendees to actively engage and learn through direct involvement.

Is there parking available?

Yes. Parking is available at DLR Lexicon from 7am to 11pm. The daily rate is $\in 6$.

Will lunch be provided?

Yes. Food and drinks will be provided at coffee and lunch breaks. Please ensure to listany dietary requirements on your application form.

Is there accommodation nearby?
